Crossing the Alternative Delivery Border

The award-winning Otay Mesa Land Port of Entry (LPOE) Modernization and Expansion project in San Diego for the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) exemplifies how even challenging projects can benefit from alternative delivery, explains Hill International Inc. Senior Director of Projects Luis Espinosa.

Espinosa, who led the Hill team's Construction Manager as Agent (CMa) support for GSA, says, "Otay Mesa is the second-busiest commercial crossing on the U.S.-Mexico border. And GSA chose to employ design-build delivery to help the crossing's many tenant agencies meet their missions while minimizing impacts to operations."

The project involved multiple interfacing components, including a new 36,000-sq-ft Commercial Annex Building, major renovations to the Main Pedestrian Building, a new 16,000-sq-ft U.S. Department of Agriculture plant inspection station, a new 13,000-sq-ft hazardous material inspection and containment facility and a new 76,000-sq-ft parking structure.

Espinosa explains: "As CMa, a key part of our role was leveraging our expertise with design-build delivery. To support the design-builder in such a complex, security-intensive and scope-heavy environment, we implemented a tracking log to manage all open issues. The log contributed to

success in many ways, especially in managing the schedule." During COVID-19, for example, the team made certain the sites remained accessible and that personnel were cleared to work. Ultimately, the team's efforts entirely mitigated COVID-19's schedule impact.

"Alternative delivery offers owners many potential benefits," Espinosa concludes. "What this project shows is that, with the right partners, even the most complex projects can realize those benefits." •
